- x Download and install Google Maps on your smartphone
- x Open sharable SU campus walkabout placemarks by clicking on one of these web addresses or using the QR code.

- x The Google Maps app should open and zoom to the placemarks (Red Icons) and route. <sup>^ h</sup>
  - o Note: Changing the base layer to imagery makes the icons and route more visible.
- x You can follow the blue route to the suggested locations which are symbolized by Red and sequentially numbered.
- x Or you can click on a Red icon, and select Directions to see additional possible routes and the estimated time to arrival.
  - o Note: Be sure to select Walking directions on screen top.
  - o Also Note: Google will only give you a route on what it believes is a sidewalk!
  - o Also, Also Note: GPS doesn't work properly inside a building!
- x You can also click on the next Red icon and select Add Stop on screen bottom to construct a sequence of stops (or route). You can add as many stops as you like or simply navigate between each location.
- x Click Start to receive verbal directions from Google Maps.
- x Several placemarks have additional information available if you click the Red icon.
- x If the Purple icons and route disappear, reload the Walkabout map from the shared address or QR code.
